# DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How does Esther's profession as a war correspondent influence her personal life?
2. How does Esther's disappearance act as a catalyst for the protagonist's transformative journey?
3. What role do Esther's letters play in unraveling the protagonist's past mistakes and future aspirations?
4. What does the motif of travel represent in the protagonist's quest for meaning and clarity?
5. How do cultural and historical references in the book, such as Islamic tradition, contribute to the narrative?
6. Explore the symbolism of landmarks, like the Arc de Triomphe and the Hôtel Bristol, in the narrative.
7. How does the inclusion of mythological elements, such as the story of Narcissus, enrich the narrative?
8. What role do memory and nostalgia play in shaping the protagonist's perceptions and actions?
9. How does the narrative structure, including flashbacks and reflections, enhance our understanding of the characters?
10. How are moments of epiphany or realization presented, and what impact do they have on the story's progression?
11. Explore the tension between the public and private personas of the characters and its importance in the narrative.
