## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How does Esther's profession as a war correspondent influence her personal life?
- **2.** How does Esther's disappearance act as a catalyst for the protagonist's transformative journey?
- **3.** What role do Esther's letters play in unraveling the protagonist's past mistakes and future aspirations?
- **4.** What does the motif of travel represent in the protagonist's quest for meaning and clarity?
- **5.** How do cultural and historical references in the book, such as Islamic tradition, contribute to the narrative?
- 6. Explore the symbolism of landmarks, like the Arc de Triomphe and the Hôtel Bristol, in the narrative.
- 7. How does the inclusion of mythological elements, such as the story of Narcissus, enrich the narrative?
- 8. What role do memory and nostalgia play in shaping the protagonist's perceptions and actions?
- 9. How does the narrative structure, including flashbacks and reflections, enhance our understanding of the characters?
- 10. How are moments of epiphany or realization presented, and what impact do they have on the story's progression?
- 11. Explore the tension between the public and private personas of the characters and its importance in the narrative.
